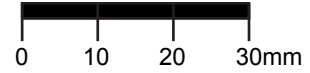

## HOW TO DETERMINE YOUR RING SIZE

Ring sizing is tricky! Our team created this guide to help but we highly recommend going to a local jeweler and getting sized in person.

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Measure the bar on the right and make sure it measures exactly 30mm.



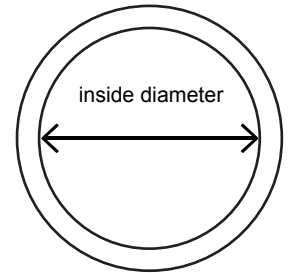
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### METHOD 1

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#### MEASURE CURRENT RING

1. Select a ring that properly fits the intended finger.
2. Place the ring over the circles below, lining up the inside edge of the ring with the circle nearest in size. This measurement refers to the inside diameter of the ring.
3. If your size is between two sizes, always order the larger size.

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## METHOD 2

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### MEASURE YOUR FINGER

Your ring should fit your finger comfortably; snug enough so that it will not fall off, but loose enough to slide over your knuckle.

- Measure your finger at the end of the day and when your fingers are warm. (Fingers are smaller in the early morning and when cold.)

1. Cut a strip of paper approximately 15cm in length and no more than 0.5cm wide
2. Wrap it around the largest part of your finger and use a pen to mark the point on the strip of paper where it forms a circle.
3. Lay the strip of paper flat and measure the distance from the end of the paper to the mark you make. (Your measurement is the 'Circumference' of the ring)
4. Compare your measurement with the Ring Size Conversion chart below to determine your size.

As paper can stretch or twist, so this method is for reference only, we highly recommend going to a local jeweler and getting sized in person.

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## TIPS

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### BUYING THE RING AS A SURPRISE

Ask your significant other's friends or mother if they know her finger size.

Borrow one of your significant other's rings (from the correct finger) and use the ring measurements above to determine its size.

### WHEN TWO SIZE SEEM TO FIT

If you hesitate between two size, always go with the larger one which allow spaces for re-sizing.

### FOR WIDER BAND RINGS

If you are purchasing a wide band, you will be more comfortable moving up half a size from your measurement.

### BIG KNUCKLES

If your knuckle is considerably larger than the base of your finger, when using a virtual ruler, measure both the base of your finger and your knuckle, and select a size in between the two.
